It is a robust list of initiatives that touch on all aspects of the Academy's mission as it looks to implement its 2030 Strategic Plan.

The ESC is meeting in April, working to narrow, and ultimately select, the specific initiatives that will comprise the Class Gift focus and goals. Then, we will work with the Foundation staff to set the timing for sharing project details with you and begin to solicit gift support.

We recognize that there are many ways to support our alma mater, with making charitable gifts to the Foundation being one of these. Ideally, components of the project will appeal to many of you and we will reach both participation and gift amount targets. We acknowledge that some may have an area of interest that may not specifically included in the project.
