Jim hailed from Wooster, Ohio, was a member of Stalag 17 plebe year, and graduated with the 33rd Herd. At the Academy, Jim studied Oceanography and started his storied SWO career as the USNA YP Commodore. A great friend and shipmate, Jim was a SWO's SWO – commanding USS HOWARD (DDG 83), DESRON 7 and also as the CO of the NROTC unit at University of Florida.

A Burial service will be held at <u>St. Catherine's Cemetery Chapel</u> (1247 Drinker Turnpike, Covington Township, PA 18444) (a few miles outside of Scranton, PA) <u>on Wednesday, 17 July 2024 at 1100, with a graveside</u> <u>commitment at 1200</u>.
